Paper plate goat



Supplies you will need:

- 2 paper plates
- brown paint
- paintbrush
- brown tissue paper
- scissors
- black card paper
- googly eyes
- black marker
- stapler
- glue

Alternatively you can use

Coloured pens, pencils, crayons White paper

Directions:

- 1 Fold in the sides of your paper plate to resemble a goat face. From the other plate cut the ears and horns for your goat
- 2. Paint your goat face and the tops of the ears with brown paint and let them dry. Or you can colour your goat using your pens/pencils/crayons, or leave it white if you prefer to.





- 3. Glue brown tissue paper squares on the bottom rim of the paper plate goat face to make his beard. (You could also paint this a different colour, or skip this step all together,) Once the tissue paper has dried enough, cut slits all along the tissue paper to define the beard.
- 4. Use a stapler to attach the ears and the horns to the paper plate goat face.



5. Cut a nose out of your black card paper and glue it onto your face. Finish your billy goat by gluing on two large googly eyes and drawing a mouth with your black marker.
