<u>Impact and Outcomes at the end of the year – July 2020</u>

Across the year we had on average 54 children eligible for Early Years Pupil Premium.

Autumn 2019 – 48 children (£5,300.74)

Spring 2020 - 57 children (£4,952.85)

Summer 2020 - 56 children (£5,787.60)

We have received £16,041.19 this academic year

Barriers to Learning from baseline September 2019

Low attainment on entry especially in areas of Understanding of the World and Literacy Low attainment on entry in aspects Reading and people and communities Low attendance levels for some children in receipt of EYPP

This year we provided an additional hour per day in a nurture group for each of our children who qualify for EYPP. As we had a high number of EYPP children from September we had to have 2 nurture groups running at once so we were still able to offer all of them a place each day. Staffing had to therefore increase as the numbers in the groups increased.

Autumn term – 4 staff worked in the nurture group approx. costing £3600

Spring term – 4 staff worked in the nurture group approx. £3600

Summer term – 6 staff worked in the nurture group approx. £5,400

Admin costs to support the attendance of the EYPP children were approx. £1000 over the year and additional resources purchases were approx. £2000

The activities in the nurture groups varied throughout the sessions and focused on supporting our desired outcomes.

Desired Outcome

- 1. Narrow the gap in 'Maths' and 'Physical development' and the aspect 'Speaking' between Pupils with Pupil premium and those without.
- 2. Improved attainment of those EYPP children in aspects Reading and People and Communities and the areas Literacy and Understanding of the World
- 3. To ensure that 95% of the EYPP children make at least typical progress in these areas and aspects

4. Improved attendance for children in receipt of EYPP
